

NNA District 3:

Seeking Nominations for the following Board Positions and Terms.

NOMINATIONS ARE DUE BY: September 1st.

President Elect: (2 year term) Individual will serve 1 year as President Elect and then the 2nd year as Board of Director President. As President, the individual is responsible for the operations of the District Board of Directors but also sits on the State NNA Board of Directors. As President Elect, the individual assists the President in their duties and serves in the capacity that the President is not available.

Treasurer: (2 year term) Responsible for preparing an annual budget, reporting on the District's finances on a monthly basis and works closely with the State Office to ensure that accurate recording and distributions from the District account. Includes assisting with a fundraiser for the annual scholarship awards.

NOTE: Co Chairs are elected on alternating years to ensure that 1 Chair has a year's worth of experience.

Program Co Chair (2 year term): Responsible for coordinating the District educational events, primarily the Celebrate Nursing Event in the Spring and the Annual meeting in the Fall. Includes coordinating the Silent Auction Event.

Publications and PR Co Chair (2 year term): Responsible for gathering articles and preparing a quarterly publication for District Members (this is the Perspectives Newsletter). This committee is also responsible for the Nurse of the Day awards.

Legislative Co Chair (2 year term): Responsible for ensuring that the District operational guidelines are up to date and being followed. Also works with the State level Commission on Advocacy and Representation to communicate legislative activity that is of interest to the District members. This Committee is also responsible for developing relationships with Legislators who represent the areas within the NNA District.

Nominations and Membership Co Chair (2 year term): Responsible for welcoming new members into the District and seeking to bring back previous members. Also for maintaining current membership levels. This committee is also responsible for managing the Convention Delegate and Alternate process, seeking nominations for annual state awards and ensuring that all District Board positions are filled.
